Contract and Understanding for working events at Walnut Creek for CVP!

Thank you for being a volunteer and working our stand for the 2022 season!

If you sign up for an event, you must work the event. If for some reason you can't make it, you must find a replacement. If you do not find a replacement, you will be charged \$50 for the first offense. If you miss a second event, you will be fined an additional \$50 and also taken off the schedule for the remainder of the season. As well, if you are very late (more than an hour) you will not earn the full amount. Understand that while you are late, everyone is doing your part. We understand that sickness and emergencies happen on show days so please reach out to us ASAP and we will assist in finding a replacement for you.

1. **Arrival Times:** Must be there between an hour and a half/hour before gates open. For the bigger concerts, 1 ½ hours, for the smaller ones only 1 hour. Must have 3 registers open at all times. Runners assist with getting drinks. If you are the last to arrive, expect to be the last to leave. This will be communicated the week of on the Facebook page.
2. **PARKING** will be on the schedule. It is either at Walnut Creek OR at Southeast Raleigh and you take a shuttle over to the event. This will happen at all big events. Build in extra time to travel between the two. Parking is listed on the sign-up sheet.
3. **ATTIRE:** You will sign out a shirt from Walnut Creek at each event. You will wear sneakers/or closed toe shoes. You can wear BLACK pants, shorts or capris. Cannot be athletic shorts, yoga pants, etc. You should wear athletic shoes for your safety.
4. **PAYMENT:** Each person who works will earn a minimum of \$50 per event. If there are cash tips, they are divided and distributed at the end of the night. Credit Card tips and profits will be split/credited amongst the workers at the end of each month! The split will be 60% to the band/guard program and 40% directly to CVP. Ex: Check is for \$1000 the breakdown would be \$600 split between those that work and \$400 directly to CVP.
5. **Special Notes:** If you are working for CVP directly or Holly Springs please ignore this line. For anyone else, if you are working for another guard program, your money will be paid out once you sign a contract with another group. This is to protect you and the money you earned. **NO ONE receives cash payouts for working an event!** If you work an event and do not march/spin, the money is forfeited to CVP. We cannot pay anyone for working. You may opt to pay another program for the purposed of a scholarship, to buy CVP merchandise or to order tickets for WGI World Championships.
6. At some events you may be placed in another stand. Each group runs theirs differently. So they may not want to split cash tips at the end of the night (they aren't very much since the park is cashless). You will still get paid through CVP!
7. We must separate trash to utilize an onsite compost bin. Bottles/Cans/Cardboard will be placed in the bin in the stand. At the end of the night all of that and trash is brought to the big bins.
8. Your profit is determined by how much you sell and how big of tips we receive. ALWAYS offer a pretzel and water with everything and don't forget to remind them we are working for the kids!
