## **Packing List**

- Medicine (must complete medicine form by Thursday 10/31)
- Uniform Attire (compression shirt, compression shorts, tall black socks, marching shoes, gloves)
- Water Jug (filled)
- Show Shirts, Jeans, optional comfy shoes
- Black Jacket: West Band or WJHS Logos only, absolutely no other logos
- Towel or Blanket to possibly sit on the grass if bleachers are full
- Bed Sheets and/or Blanket and/or Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Shower Shoes
- Towels for Showering
- Toiletries
- Pajamas
- School appropriate swimsuit
- Beach Towel
- Plastic Bag for Wet Clothes/towel
- Frisbee, Bocce Ball, other beach fun
- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Bug Spray
- Phone Charger + any for other devices

## **Meals**

*Saturday:* Eat breakfast before arrival.

Pre-Order Meal while on the way to Havelock. Pack snacks as needed for bus rides.

Snack provided by BPA while warming up for performance.

Pre-Order Meal after performance. Concessions (Out of Pocket, ~\$15) as needed.

*Sunday:* Breakfast provided at Don Lee Camp. Lunch provided by BPA at the Beach.

Pack snacks as needed for bus rides.



## Reminders

- Use the smallest bag possible when packing. A carry-on size suitcase or a small duffel bag should provide enough room to pack for a 2-day trip.
  - You should use a separate small gym bag for your marching band uniform items that can be packed within your other bag.
- Read the itinerary for the daily attire. (Pack light!; limit what you bring to the designated daily attire, pajamas, toiletries and the few items noted/suggested below.)
- Everyone needs a BLACK jacket. If you do not have a band jacket or hoodie, it must be *plain black (absolutely no other color, design, writing, etc.)*.
- Consider bringing hand warmers or one small blanket/towel to use in the stadium.
- Consider bringing extra money for snacks and souvenirs. There are usually awesome shirts for sale and lots of food. You are responsible for what you bring. If your money is lost, it is your responsibility.
- Consider bringing a portable phone charger so that you always have a way for communication.

## Expectations

- You must *always* travel with a Two. You cannot ever walk alone.
- You must wear the assigned daily attire for each day. This is to easily identify you in a crowd and keep you safe.
- Anything that you bring is your responsibility.
- Do not bring large gaming consoles. You may bring a Switch or similar device for the bus ride.
- We will not have extras of uniform items. Double check that you have packed all needed items for each day.
- Students must stay with the band for the entire weekend.
  - Only go into the room that you are assigned.
  - Students are NOT allowed in Parent rooms.
  - NON-Chaperone parents are NOT allowed in Student rooms.
- While in your room, halls, and common areas, talk at a reasonable level (no yelling).
- At lights-out, everyone should be in their assigned rooms and ready for bed. Chaperones will come and check rooms.
  - After they have checked your room, lock the door and do not open it until the chaperone wakes you up the next morning.
  - Your door will be taped. *If the tape is broken, there are consequences.*
- Be respectful of other guests, especially on Sunday morning when in the breakfast area.
- Do not jump on the beds or break anything in the rooms.
- Clean up after yourself at breakfast - YOUR MAMA AIN'T HERE!!
